

Virtually Glasgow West End ... is an orienteering challenge using the Clydeside Orienteers' Urban Map of Glasgow's West End and Google Maps Street View.

The object of the game is to work around the course and use your combined orienteering skills and ability to delve into the Google Maps Street View technology in order to answer the following questions at each of the control sites (centre of each circle on the orienteering map). You may need to zoom-in for some controls. You don't have to stay in Street View between the controls (this is only optional and likely to be much harder!)

To help you locate the start, it is adjacent to Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum. Please note that there are questions at both the start and the finish, and that the planner used the latest 2020 version of Street View. Have fun !
